EU-Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS-Directive)

According to the EU-Directive 2011/65/EU (hereafter referred to as the “Recast RoHS Directive” or “RoHS II”) has been published in the Official Journal of the EU on 1st July 2011 and entered into force on 21st July 2011. Member States will have to transpose the Recast RoHS Directive into national law by 2nd January 2013 at the latest.

The RoHS directive is subject to a continuous re-evaluation cycle. This means that every four years new substances might be forbidden or exceptional rules might be omitted or newly affiliated.

Effective the following substances used in electronic products are within the limits of the directive:

- Lead (Pb) of 1000ppm
- Mercury (Hg)
- Cadmium (Cd)
- Hexavalent chrome (Cr (VI))
- Polybrominated biphenyl (PBB)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ehters (PBDE)
- Examination of substance list possible as soon as scientific evidence is available
